Up until now, your teachers and counselors have pretty much told you what classes you needed to take and when you needed to take them in order to graduate.

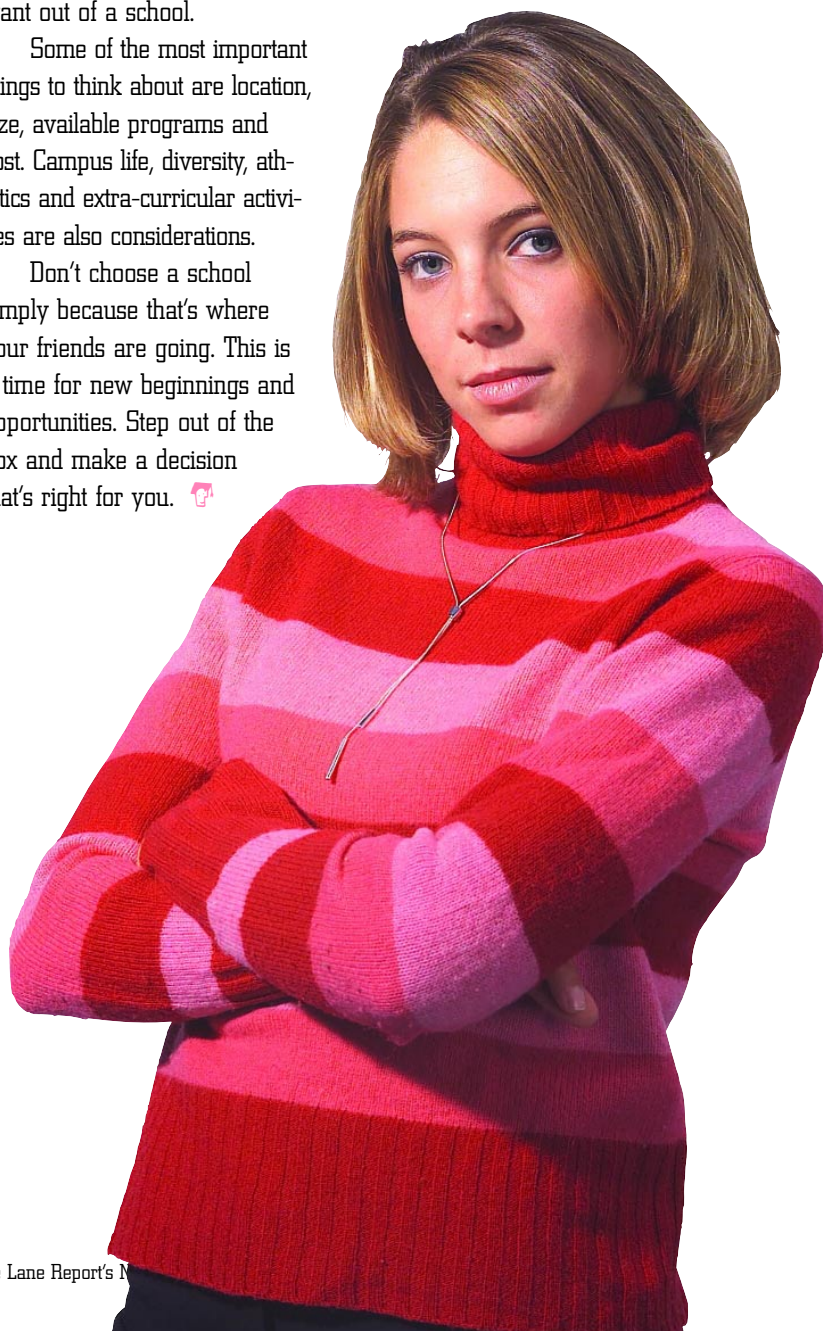
