

Earn While You Learn!

If you don't qualify for a scholarship or financial aid – or if you're still short on cash after those funds come through – don't give up!

A number of Kentucky companies encourage their employees to continue their education by helping to foot the bill.

UPS' "Earn & Learn" program provides college students with part-time jobs and up to \$4,000 per year in educational assistance. To encourage student-employees to do well, the work is limited to less than five hours per day, with set shift schedules and no weekend or holiday work. A special educational loan program is also available to student-employees whereby UPS will repay all or a portion of the loan (based on the employee's length of service).

Metropolitan College is a program coordinated by UPS, the state of Kentucky, the University of Louisville, Jefferson Community College and



Kentucky Technical College. The program requires that students work part-time in the UPS Louisville operations between 10 p.m. and 4 a.m. in exchange for a free education at any one of the three colleges.

Since students work at night and sleep and attend classes during the day, special class schedules and dorm arrangements are provided for students in the program.

Other companies offer on-site, hands-on learning programs that provide training in specific fields. For example, if
