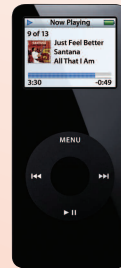

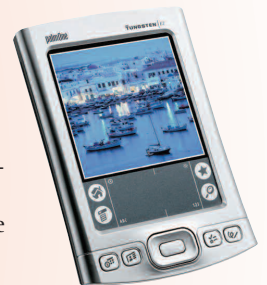
Canon PowerShot A520
